"Sleeping Dogs" Inquiries

At our retreat last August, the Trillium Awakening Teachers Circle engaged in an exercise led by Joanne Lee to identify shadow areas within our organization. There were three categories:

1) Barking dogs - Tensions we are aware of that need our immediate attention; 2) Quiet Dogs - Areas of concern that we know about but which are presently dormant; and 3) Sleeping dogs - those unseen and unacknowledged areas that could, over time, wake up and bite us.

About a dozen "sleeping dog" categories were noted by those present and through later polling. We have begun to discuss these areas on our monthly teacher calls, and are finding the conversations timely and valuable. Since the Teachers Retreat, we've discussed territoriality, collective vs. association identity, our relationship with IAM, and transitioning from the senior teacher category to our current Elder and Visionary Councils.

We plan to continue these discussions on a regular basis as foundational to who we are as an evolving spiritual organization. We've already experienced personally and professionally what surprises can happen if we don't make this a priority.


